Topic: The Attributes of God

Scriptures: Exodus 34: 6-7, Psalm 139: 1-6, 1 John 4:7-10, Romans 1:20, and Lamentations 3: 22-23

Questions:

1. In Exodus 34:6-7, God describes Himself with attributes such as being merciful and just. How do these attributes coexist in God's character, and what does that mean for how we understand His actions?
2. Psalm 139:1-6 reveals God's omniscience, stating that He knows us intimately. How does understanding that God knows every detail about our lives affect your relationship with Him and your confidence in His plans for you?
3. 1 John 4:7-10 highlights the centrality of God's love. How should the understanding that God is love shape the way we interact with others and ourselves? What are practical ways we can embody this love in our daily lives?
