Topic: Sermon On The Mount: Part III, Personal Relationships

In this portion of the Sermon On The Mount, Jesus presents the true interpretation of the law and what it looks like to live them out in our personal relationships with one another, daily. His intent is to paint the full picture of the desire of God and His purpose of the law to begin with, rather than what the scribes and Pharisees were teaching at the time.
