Questions:

2. In John 14:15-17, how does Jesus describe the role of the Holy Spirit as the Advocate? How does this inform our understanding of the ongoing presence of God in our lives?

3. According to Romans 8:9-17, what does it mean to live according to the Spirit, and how can the fruit of the Spirit serve as evidence of His work in our lives?
